Jesus heals a blind man from birth (9:1-7)

- Sixth miracle performed by Jesus on blindness (9:1)
 - Bartimaeus in Jericho (Mark 10:46-52), two more in Galilee (Matt 9:27-31), a blind man without speech and demon possessed(Matt 12:22-23), in Bethsaida (Mark 8:22-26) one in Jerusalem (Matt 21:14)
- Compassion, opportunity, Power of God
- Disciples Origin of suffering (9:2-4)
 - Suffering is not always due to sin (Luke 13:2-3)
 - Greater glory of God (Crucifixion John 12:28, "I have glorified it and will glorify it again)
- Light of the world (9:5)
 - Makes his light shine upon you (Num 6:25)
 - Ezekiel's vision of God (Eze 1:4), light to shine out of darkness (2 Cor:46)
 - Moses face was radiant because he had spoken with the Lord (Exo 34:29)
- Clay & Spittle (9:6) Ancient remedies
 - Jesus healing blind by spitting in his eyes (Mark 8:22-26)
- Sent to wash (9:7),
 - (Jesus John 3:17), (For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.)
 - (Naaman's healing 2 Kings 5:10-13)

Questioning the healing (9: 8-34)

- The neighbors (9: 8-13)
 - Confused, Weak people who needs help from Pharisees
- The Pharisees (9: 14-17)
 - Pass Judgement, Sabbath day sin, Customs & their principalities
- The man's parents (9: 18-23)
 - Passing the buck
- Back to the formerly blind man (9: 24-33)
 - If any man be a worshipper of God and doeth his will, him he heareth (through Jesus) (9:31)
 - Jesus our only way to forgive our sins. Old Testament sacrifices vs New Testament sacrifices
- Jesus (Savior) (9:11) to Prophet (Teacher) (9:17) to Christ (Messiah) (9:22) to God (Creator) (9:33)
- Casted out of the synagogue (9:34), Be mindful, it is not about us, Basic goodness, benefit of doubt, Office examples as leaders (Find out what their issue is before taking a decision

- Jesus visits the healed man (9:35)
 - Persecution on us (2 Cor:8-10)
- The healed man's belief (9:36-38)
- Spiritual blindness (9:39-41) (The Father & Son story)
 - Satan's role in keeping us away from Christ (2 Cor 4:4)
 - Judas (John 70-71)Betrays
 - Jesus Commission (Matt 28:17) Doubters
